## **Gabriola Music Fest 2017**

## **Terms and Conditions**

The Gabriola Arts Council agrees to:

- 1. Clearly mark the 10'x10' foot area for each stall.
- 2. Provide links to vendor websites on our website: www.gabriolamusicfest.com.
- 3. Assign vendors to stalls by lottery where possible and in such a way as to provide an appealing presentation to customers.
- 4. Notify each vendor by email of his/her stall number and loading schedule at least one week prior to the event.
- 5. Provide volunteers if available to help vendors unload and load their vehicles.

As a vendor participating in Gabriola Music Fest 2017, I:

- 1. Have joined the Gabriola Arts Council at least until December 31, 2017 (or will be purchasing a membership with this registration). Artists on the 2017 Studio Tour are already members.
- 2. Will pay the required fees when I register either in person or online.
- 3. Will abide by the set-up and take-down schedule and procedure.
- 4. Will park my vehicle away from the Twin Beaches Mall.
- 5. Will provide all necessary equipment to construct my stall in the 10'x10' space provided, including but not limited to a table, tent, signage, power, and umbrella—and, if possible, a person to help unload and load.
- 6. Will have my stall ready for business Saturday, September 2nd; by 10:30 am, unless otherwise approved by the Gabriola Arts Council.
- 7. Understand that I am participating for both days and that if I choose to leave my stall overnight, I am doing so at my own risk.
- 8. At the end of the Festival, I will promptly remove my wares, equipment, and anything else I have brought onto the site.

## Set-up and Take-down Procedure

- 1. Arrive at a time to be determined. This time will be provided to vendors no later than one week before the event.
- 2. Arrive at Twin Beaches Mall and wait for direction to proceed to the numbered area for your stall.
- 3. Offload as quickly as possible. Do not start setting up until your vehicle has been removed from the site.

- 4. Remove your vehicle from Twin Beaches Mall, and park away away from the site before setting up your stall. This will avoid traffic jams.
