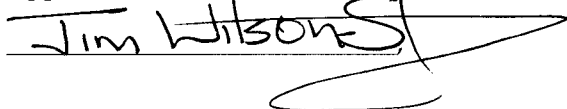

Notes to the Financial Statements

For the Year Ended June 30, 2015

(Unaudited)

Nature of Business

The Gabriola Arts Council is an organization that provides administration and funding support to local visual and performance artists, musicians and writers. The Council was incorporated under the Societies Act of British Columbia as a not-for-profit organization on April 15, 1997, and is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act.

1. Significant Accounting Policies

a. Basis of Accounting

The Gabriola Arts Council prepares its financial statements in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations.

b. Other Accounting Policies

Contributed capital assets are recorded at fair value.

Contributed material and services are not recorded in the financial statements

Pledges receivable are recorded when received.

c. Capital Assets

Capital assets are recorded at cost. Amortization is provided annually at rates calculated to write off the assets over their estimated useful lives as follows:

Computer equipment	30% straight line
Building	20 years straight line

Additions during the year are amortized at one-half their normal rate and no amortization is taken in the year of disposition.

d. Other Revenue Recognition Points

Membership fees are recognized over the membership period.

Unrestricted contributions are recognized as revenue when received or receivable if the amount to be received can be reasonably estimated and collection is reasonably assured.

Revenue from activities and events is recognized when the activity or event occurs.

The cut-off date for donations is the same as the cut-off date for receipts issued in a year, and is based on the postage date on the envelope for mail, or the date the donation is received.

Legacies or bequests are recorded when received.

1. Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

e. Use of Estimates

When preparing financial statements according to Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations, the Council makes estimates and assumptions. Management's assumptions are based on a number of factors, including historical experience, current events and actions that the organization may undertake in the future, and other assumptions that we believe are reasonable under the circumstances. Actual results could differ from those estimates under different conditions and assumptions. Estimates were used when accounting for certain items, such as the useful lives of capital assets and impairment of long-lived assets .
